#### Directions To Doubletree by Hilton Westlake

**From Erie and Points North East:** Take I-90 West to Cleveland. Take I-90 West to Crocker Rd in Westlake. Take exit 156 from I-90 at Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn right onto Crocker Rd. Turn at next left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.

**From Downtown Cleveland:** Follow I-90 West. Take I-90 West to Crocker Rd in Westlake. Take exit 156 from I-90 at Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn right onto Crocker Rd. Turn at next left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.

**From Youngstown or Pittsburgh PA and Points East:** Continue on I-680 N. Take I-80 West, I-77 North. Follow I-77 North to I-490 West to I-90 West. Take I-90 West to Crocker Rd in Westlake. Take exit 156 from I-90 at Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn right onto Crocker Rd. Turn at next left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.



From Toledo and Points West: Take I-90 East toward Cleveland. Follow I-90 East to Crocker Rd in Westlake. Take exit 156 from I-90 for Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Turn left onto Crocker Rd. Turn left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.

From Cincinnati, Columbus, and Points South: Take I-71 North toward Cleveland. Follow I-71 north to Exit 240. Take exit 240 for West 150<sup>th</sup> Street. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto W 150<sup>th</sup> St. Continue onto Warren Rd. Turn left onto Lakewood Heights Blvd.. Use the left lane to merge onto I-90 W via the ramp to Toledo. Take Exit 156 for Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn right onto Crocker Rd. Turn at next left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.

From Dayton Take I-70 East to Columbus. Take I-270 to I-71 North towards Cleveland. Follow I-71 North to Exit 240. Take exit 240 for West 150<sup>th</sup> Street. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto W 150<sup>th</sup> St. Continue onto Warren Rd. Turn left onto Lakewood Heights Blvd.. Use the left lane to merge onto I-90 W via the ramp to Toledo. Take Exit 156 for Crocker Rd toward Bassett Rd. Use the 2<sup>nd</sup> from the right lane to turn right onto Crocker Rd. Turn at next left onto Clemens Rd. Turn at first right. The hotel will be on your left.

#### What is the purpose of the Area 54 Mini-Conference?

This Mini-Conference was developed to give our Delegate the informed conscience of the groups in Area 54— Northeast Ohio - on some of the agenda items that will be addressed at the General Service Conference. Due to time constraints, it is not possible to address all of the agenda of the General Service Conference. The selected agenda is mailed to the registered General Service Representatives (GSRs) of the groups in advance. The group **can discuss the issues and send their group's conscience to the Mini**-Conference via their GSR. At the Mini-Conference the issues are discussed with GSRs from many groups throughout Area 54. Using the committee system and voting procedures described in the AA Service Manual, a consensus is reached. This consensus is taken to the General Service Conference by our delegate, who still maintains the right of decision described in the Twelve Concepts.

The Mini-Conference will also feature displays and information provided by the Area 54 Standing Committees and a variety of ways for a GSR to share with others committed to their service to others. GSRs can meet a General Service Board trustee, a staff member from the General Service Office and the Area Committee. There are also sharing sessions for GSRs and an Ask-it-basket hosted by past delegates, the trustee and GSO staff member.

#### Why do I have to pay?

While there are no dues or fees for membership in AA, it is the practice of Area 54 General Service that each individual event be self-supporting. This conference requires months of planning, preparation and money to present. Our expenses include printing of the background material and purchase of literature relevant to the agenda that will be discussed, printing of flyers and schedules, mailing costs and registration supplies. We do not pay our speakers, but we do provide for their expenses to attend the conference. At times we have snack or beverage expenses. The hospitality rooms are self-supporting of themselves. The Saturday Night Speaker is an open A.A. Meeting and is the only function that will not require attendees to be registered.
