Dear Delegate & Committee Officers:

Writing this letter as a result of doing wrong towards this program and fellowship is one of the hardest things I've needed to do in sobriety this far. Please know that it was never my plan to harm anyone nor the program. As thing after thing materialized in my life, instead of increasing recovery to deal I went back into my old thoughts and reactions. With every situation and the pain it caused, I used outward validation and other unhealthy ways of dealing with it. There has been many times I've wanted to admit my wrongs to the panel and that I truly regret but secrets have never killed me as well as the shame and remorse. My fight to have approval and acceptance has landed in this current situation and needing to get help even outside of AA. So, I fully plan to make financial amends to the Area. Once our tasks settle down, we can make a plan for repayment.

As far as the business side of the situation, there are several things I need to say. Those Facebook charges of \$3000 plus were a hacking. I have repaid quite a bit already but I didn't show proof. It was just added into the deposits. There is also a large payment that came out for QuickBooks that wasn't authorized and they also stated we weren't going to be charged.

Finally, I've honestly haven't been able to get in Zoom, the Square, Quick Books, and online banking. The Microsoft account has a problem with payment from us so Dan M. paid it and I sent him a check for reimbursement. There are stipend checks, expenses and invoices covered in a group of checks I'm turning over.

Once again I do apologize for this situation I've created. I am willing and expect to make amends.
